- Limit one voucher per property.
- Current proof of property ownership/tenancy within West Torrens must be presented on the day.
- Tree must be planted in the ground on private property within West Torrens (this does not include the verge).
- All tree maintenance (watering, pruning) is the responsibility of the property owner (or tenant).
- The tree must be planted at least 2 metres from the property boundary to minimise overhanging of neighbouring properties and/or the verge.
- Tenants must provide approval in writing from the property owner (landlord) to plant the tree at the rental property.

- Strata title properties must include written proof of support by the body corporate to plant a tree on their property.
- Due to limited stock, please be aware preferred tree species may not be available on the day.
- Council may conduct random follow-up inspections.
- Council will not be held responsible for the growth or performance of the tree.
