

South Australian **FOOD SAFETY RATING SCHEME**



INFORMING CONSUMERS about how **WELL EATERIES** **COMPLY** with **FOOD SAFETY STANDARDS**.



A **STAR RATING** is calculated after a **FOOD SAFETY INSPECTION** by the Local Council.



INFORMATION about the food safety of businesses **HELPS CONSUMERS** make informed choices about where **THEY EAT**.

Eateries from participating councils are awarded stars if they achieve a high degree of compliance in Food Safety Standards.



- 5 STARS** - EXCELLENT
- 4 STARS** - VERY GOOD
- 3 STARS** - GOOD



Certificates are only awarded once a **ROUTINE INSPECTION** is undertaken which **MAY BE ONCE EVERY 12 MONTHS**.

Just because a business is not displaying a certificate, **DOES NOT MEAN THEY ARE UNSAFE**.
