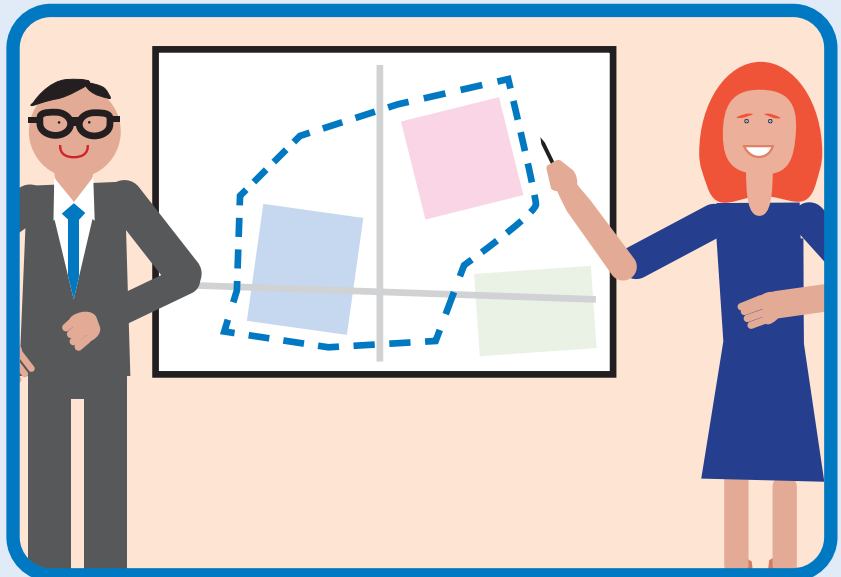

Guidelines for City of West Torrens Local Government Studies Grant



1. Council vision

Committed to be best place to live, work and enjoy life.

2. Purpose of the grants

Local Government Studies Grants Program provides funding to assist students 18 and over to study Local Government, aligned with the [*Council's Community Plan 2034*](#).

3. Grant amount:

Council funding for local government studies: up to \$500.

4. Eligibility criteria

- 4.1 An individual resident of the City of West Torrens.
- 4.2 Aged 18 years or older at the time of undertaking this subject.
- 4.3 The applicant is required to submit a proof of their residential address such as recent copy of Council rates notice or utility bill.
- 4.4 Participating or studying in South Australian tertiary institutions undertaking studies in Local Government.
- 4.5 The applicant is required to submit proof that they are participating in the local government studies (i.e. enrolment notice).
- 4.6 Applications must be received at least 2 weeks before studies start.
- 4.7 Only one application per individual can be submitted in the same financial year.

5. Accountability

Successful applicants are required to complete an acquittal form through SmartyGrants and submit a comprehensive report detailing the local government studies experience and its outcomes. This report must include a photo and a summary and should be submitted within six weeks after the local government studies end.

7. Funding allocation

Funding for these grants is limited each financial year. Once the allocated funds are completely utilised, no additional applications will be accepted until the new financial year begins.
