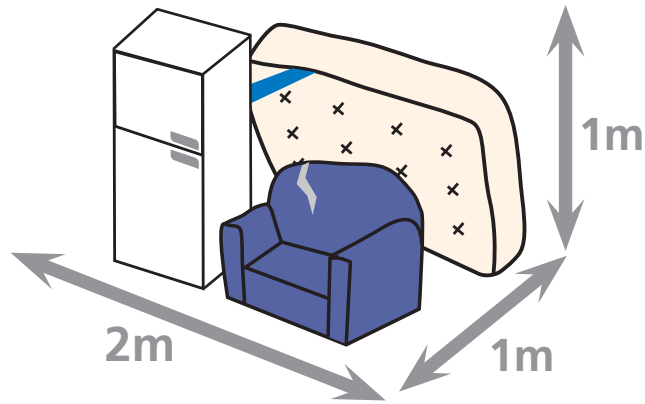


Placing items out for collection

- Items should be placed on the verge no earlier than the night before the collection date.
- A limit of two cubic metres of waste (2m x 1m x 1m) per household applies.
- Items must not exceed two metres in length.
- Items must be able to be lifted safely by two people.

Illegal dumping

Hard waste items placed on the verge without a booking or earlier than the night before the collection date will be considered to be illegal dumping and may incur a fine. The minimum fine for illegal dumping is \$210 and increases according to the type and volume of material.

Booking a collection

Residents are entitled to two free booked collections per financial year.

To book:

- phone Solo Resource Recovery on 8295 5077
- complete the online form at westtorrens.sa.gov.au/hardwaste
- older residents and those with disability who are unable to arrange for family and friends to place items out for collection should phone Home Assist on 8416 6251.

Waiting times will vary according to the level of demand and may be longer in Spring and early Summer. Bookings will be confirmed by email or letter and you will be provided with Collection Guidelines and a label to attach to your hard waste.

Note: consider donating items in good condition to not-for-profit or community organisations.

Waste voucher

Owners or occupiers of residential property are entitled to a voucher to dispose of a 6' x 4' trailer load of general waste equal to 2 cubic metres (2m x 1m x 1m) at Adelaide Waste and Recycling Centre, 181 Morphett Road, North Plympton.

The voucher is available from Council's Civic Centre, 165 Sir Donald Bradman Drive, and is valid for one month from the date of issue. Proof of residence is required and there is a limit of one voucher per property per financial year.

Items that will be collected



- Furniture.
- Bedding.
- Mattresses - limit of 2.
- Fridges and freezers.
- Pottery and crockery.
- Bicycles and toys.
- Tools and gardening equipment.
- Lawnmowers (empty of oil and petrol).
- Hot water services and air conditioners.
- Unbroken glass, mirrors and shower screens.
- Whitegoods - eg. washing machines, dryers and stoves.
- Electronic appliances - eg. TVs and computers.
- Electrical appliances, eg. vacuum cleaners, kettles, coffee machines.
- Metal - eg. sheets of iron and guttering up to 2m lengths.
- Timber up to 2m lengths (nails removed or flattened).
- Tree prunings tied up in bundles (max 30cm diameter) - up to 2m lengths.
- Floor coverings and window treatments eg. carpet, rugs, lino, curtains, blinds up to 2m lengths.

A significant quantity of the hard waste collected can be recycled.

Note: For recycling purposes, a separate vehicle may collect some items.

Items that will NOT be collected



- No items in excess of 2 cubic metres (2m x1m x1m).
- No items in excess of 2 metres in length.
- No liquid waste eg. motor or cooking oil, chemicals.
- No hazardous waste items as defined under the Environmental Protection Act.
- No asbestos.
- No cans containing paint.
- No gas bottles.
- No fire extinguishers.
- No ceramic or terracotta items eg. toilets, basins, baths, pots.
- No concrete, bricks, rocks, dirt, cement sheeting, plasterboard or other building materials.
- No vehicle batteries.
- No car bodies, vehicle parts, panels or tyres.
- No ammunition, explosives or flares.
- No wooden pallets.
- No timber or logs exceeding 30cm diameter.
- No unbundled green organics.
- No items that can be disposed of in kerbside bins.
