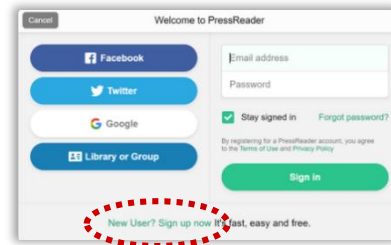
Getting started on your PC

- 1 Visit www.libraries.sa.gov.au/prlogin and enter your **Library Card number** and **PIN**, then click **Log in**

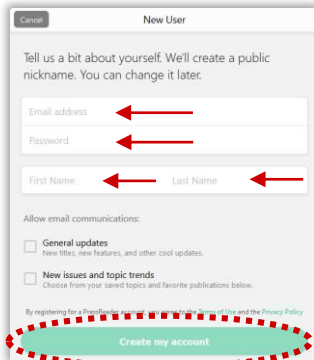
The PressReader page will appear. Near the top right of the page, click the **Sign in** icon



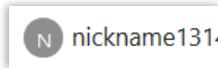
- 2 A welcome message will then appear. Click **New User? Sign up now**



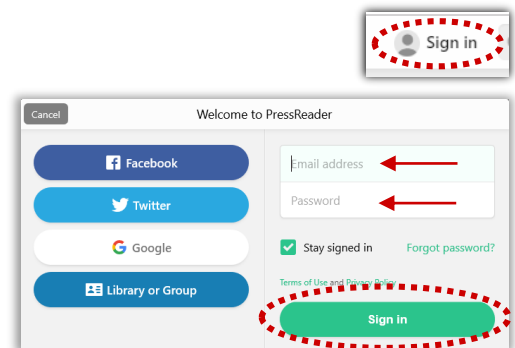

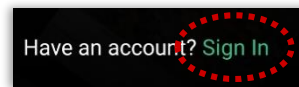
- 2 A welcome message will then appear. Click **New User? Sign up now**



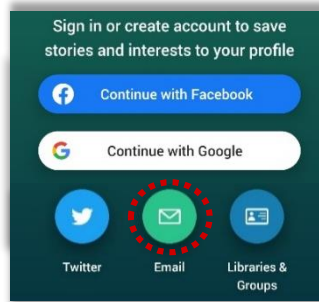
- 3 The **New User** window will appear. Enter your **Email address**, preferred **Password**, **First** and **Last name**. Then click **Create my account**



- 4 Search & install the **Press Reader** app  via  AppStore (Apple)  GooglePlay (Android)

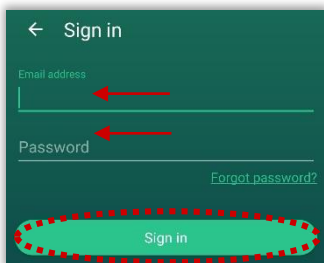


After opening the app, click **Sign in** at the bottom of the screen

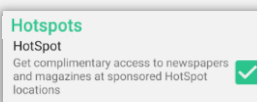
