Further, the Minister be advised that Council does have some issues of concern regarding Henley Beach Road being identified at the preferred option for the WestLINK route, specifically the section between South Road and Marion Road, and would like to work constructively with the State Government to address the concerns Council has regarding the possible loss of on-street parking, traffic congestion, tree loss and financial cost to Council ratepayers caused by the introduction of a tram along Henley Beach Road.

- 4. When this information is provided from the State Government, the City of West Torrens will appoint a working party to examine all aspects of the WestLINK tram including community feedback.
- The working party shall examine the three main suggested routes for the WestLINK tram travelling to Adelaide Airport from the city.

- c. Richmond Road

The findings and recommendations of the working party will be presented to council and the State Government on the Council's preferred route as well as any other conditions or concerns.
