10.1 Torrens to Darlington (T2D) Project update and Impacts to Council Facilities (Thebarton Oval and Kings Reserve Precinct)

Reason for Confidentiality

The Committee is satisfied that, pursuant to Section 90(3)(b)(i),(d)(i) and (j)(i) of the *Local Government Act 1999*, the information to be received, discussed or considered in relation to this agenda item is:

- (b)(i) information the disclosure of which could reasonably be expected to confer a commercial advantage on a person with whom the council is conducting, or proposing to conduct, business, or to prejudice the commercial position of the council.
- (d)(i) commercial information of a confidential nature (not being a trade secret) the disclosure of which - could reasonably be expected to prejudice the commercial position of the person who supplied the information, or to confer a commercial advantage on a third party.
- (j)(i) information the disclosure of which would divulge information provided on a confidential basis by or to a Minister of the Crown, or another public authority or official (not being an employee of the Council, or a person engaged by the Council).

Committee resolved that:

- 1. Pursuant to Section 90(2) of the Local Government Act 1999, Council orders, that the public, with the exception of the Chief Executive Officer, members of the Executive and Management Teams in attendance at the meeting, and meeting secretariat staff, be excluded from attendance at so much of the meeting as is necessary to receive, discuss and consider in confidence, information contained within the confidential report Item 10.1 - Torrens to Darlington (T2D) Project update and Impacts to Council Facilities (Thebarton Oval and Kings Reserve Precinct), attachments and any associated documentation submitted by the Chief Executive Officer, specifically on the basis of the provisions of Section 90(3)(b)(i),(d)(i) and (i)(i) because it may prejudice the commercial position of the Council and lead to Council not obtaining or securing the best possible outcome for the benefit of the Council and the community in regard to matters dealing with the Torrens to Darlington (T2D) Project.
