Scope of Services

Proposal

As per the render below, we propose to utilise the top 3.6m of the J Hallett & Son chimney stack located at the Brickworks as an alternative to the chimney at West End Brewery.


Subject to approval from council, LION and appropriately qualified engineer, McMahons Services propose to supply and install an Alucabond wrap to be fabricated 2 sections. Each section will have crane lifting points installed. The 2 sections of alucabond will be connected to the existing exoskeleton frame using and approved engineering method. The gauge of material and mounting points is to be sufficient to accept all conditions and for longevity.

The installation will require a dual crane lift. Crane 1 will lift and support the Alucabond section. Crane 2 will be equipped with an approved man box and will lift the installers to a height to install. Installers will bolt / secure the alucabond to the frame. Once Alucabond is installed Crane 1 is demobilised.

Once the Alucabond is installed, the installers will depart and sign writers / decal installers will take their place in the man box. A decal will be installed highlighting the winning team, the runner up and any additional logo's required. These decals will be installed in vertical strips as per normal sign boards. These decals will be UV protected and while will be removable, will not blow off. These will remain in place for a 12-month period until they are changed the following year.

Updating each year will only require a single crane and man box. It is possible to add decals over decals to speed up the update, but at some stage they will need to be removed.

We have investigated using a digital print vinyl banner. This would require the installation of rope track, toggle bolts / hooks with eyelets. Our supplier has not recommended this a year-round solution.





Access

Site access to complete these works will require a total exclusion zone to be established as per below. We appreciate that this is a large area, but safety is our number 1 priority. No public access to this area will be permitted during the install works.



Equipment

To allow equipment with sufficient reach capabilities, we would propose to use a 130t of 200t crane, as below. Larger cranes could be used and be placed in the vacant area adjacent South Rd, but this would be considerably more expensive. If required we will explore this as an option.

Duration

The initial Alucabond install will take 2 days and will require 2 cranes. Note that this is a one off and once installed is unlikely to require replacing for some time.

The decal installation is forecast to take 2 days. Noting that this installation can only be actioned during calm clear weather.

As it is unlikely that access will be permitted over a 4-day continuous period, the initial install will require a 2nd crane mobilisation.
