

We're making it easier to get from South Road straight to the city

Since our last update, we've been preparing for major construction which will start in early May 2025.

The \$40 million project is part of the \$850 million package of broader network upgrades, funded by the Australian and South Australian governments as part of the River Torrens to Darlington (T2D) Project.

This project is expected to be open to traffic in early 2026, weather permitting.

Upcoming works

Site establishment

Day works to establish a site compound on the south-west corner of the intersection between James Congdon Drive and Rosslyn Street, will commence from early May **2025**.

Once established, operational hours of the site compound will generally be 7am to 5pm, Monday to Friday and 7pm to 6am Sunday to Thursday.

Survey and service investigations

We will be undertaking survey and service investigation works in and around the intersection from early May 2025. These works will occur intermittently during the day and night.

Day works will be scheduled Monday to Friday, between 7am and 5pm. Night works will be undertaken Sunday to Thursday between 7pm and 6am.

Vegetation and landscaping

We understand that trees are highly valued by the community. While every effort has been made throughout the design process to retain trees and vegetation, some removals will be required to enable this important intersection upgrade. Read the 'Vegetation Fact Sheet' for more information. We will share more details about our landscaping and re-planting in the coming weeks.

Removal works will commence from early May 2025.

Major construction

Major works will start early May 2025.

Day works will be scheduled Monday to Friday, between 7am and 5pm. Night works will be undertaken Sunday to Thursday between 7pm and 6am. There will be no works Friday and Saturday nights.

Works will be rotated around the intersection to ensure that we provide respite for nearby residents and businesses.

Over the coming months, activities will include (but are not limited to):

- removal of kerbs, medians, road signage and street furniture
- installation of a retaining wall on the south east corner of the intersection
- drainage works
- lighting and signalling works
- road widening activities
- vegetation removal

Traffic management

The James Congdon Drive and Sir Donald Bradman Drive intersection will remain open to traffic during these works.

To keep everyone safe, speed and lane restrictions will be in place as required. Please follow traffic management and onsite signage.

Access to properties will be maintained during these works. If short term access restrictions are required, we will provide advance notice.
