

James Congdon Drive and Sir Donald Bradman Drive upgrade

Night works and temporary road closures

We're making it easier to get from South Road straight to the city

What's happening

Works are progressing well with the next phase of works to include ongoing service relocations, road widening, constructing the new Rosslyn Street link road, and final asphaltting works along James Congdon Drive and Sir Donald Bradman Drive.

Rosslyn Street right-turn movements

From Monday 17 November 2025, the right-in/right-out movement at Rosslyn Street and Sir Donald Bradman Drive will be permanently closed. This change is required to improve traffic flow, efficiency, and safety to all road users.

To help maintain local access, a new link road will be constructed to connect Rosslyn Street and James Congdon Drive. The link road is expected to open early-December 2025. Please see map overleaf.

Ongoing asphaltting works

Asphaltting work is continuing in and around the intersection, with works currently occurring between the intersection and Hilton Bridge.

Speed and lane restrictions are in place during working hours.

During night works Sir Donald Bradman drive will be reduced to a single lane in each direction, Sunday to Friday between 8pm and 5am for approximately two weeks.

How this affects you

Some noise disturbance can be expected at times while these works are completed, however the work will be managed to minimise disturbance to nearby residents and businesses as much as practically
