

Tram Grade Separation Projects

Marion Road and Cross Road Level Crossing Removals

Works update – May to July 2025

We're removing congested tram level crossings to make your journey safer and more reliable

This update provides information about upcoming works and changes to local access in your area.

These works will occur on Marion Road, Cross Road and local side streets, within, and around the tram corridor between Stop 9 (South Plympton) to west of Stop 11 (Plympton Park) see map overleaf.

Key upcoming activities

- preparation of rail construction storage areas and delivery of rail materials within the tram corridor near:
 - Pleasant Avenue, between Ray Street and New Street
 - the corner of Wattle Terrace and Park Terrace
- service relocation works within the tram corridor and around the Marion Road and Cross Road level crossings including local roads
- pruning and removal of vegetation and trees.

To keep everyone safe speed and lane restrictions will be in place as required. Intermittent local side road detours will also be in place as required, please observe onsite signage and directions of traffic controllers.

Outside of working hours, speed restrictions will remain in place and local road access restored wherever possible. Local access to properties will be maintained at all times but we will contact you directly if short term restrictions are required. Some noise disturbance can be expected at times during construction; however, the work will be managed to minimise noise to nearby residents and businesses as much as practically possible.

Pruning and removal of trees and vegetation

While every effort has been made to retain existing vegetation and trees, removals are required as part of the project.

Removals and pruning will occur during May and June 2025 within the rail corridor and adjacent work areas on Marion Road, Cross Road and Anzac Highway, and at local roads and side streets adjacent the tram corridor. This includes locations at Pleasant Avenue, Glengyle Terrace and Wattle Terrace.

Most of these works will occur during the day, however some night works will be required at the intersection of Marion Road and Anzac Highway to minimise impacts to traffic. Please observe onsite signage.

Temporary changes to street parking

There will be some temporary restrictions to on-street parking on side streets adjacent the tram corridor during working hours (day or night). Outside of working hours, parking restrictions will be removed wherever possible. Please observe traffic management and onsite signage.

Temporary storage facilities

We are setting up temporary rail storage areas within the rail corridor off Pleasant Avenue and Wattle Terrace. These will be used for the storage of essential construction materials.

Access to the Pleasant Avenue site will be via Cross Road and Mavis Street, and the Wattle

Terrace site via South Terrace, Acacia Street and Park Terrace.

Deliveries will take place on the weekends between 7am and 7pm at each location on the following days:

- Saturday 31 May to Monday 2 June 2025
- Saturday 21 June to Sunday 22 June 2025

Lincoln Avenue access changes

The left-turn movement into Lincoln Avenue from Anzac Highway will be permanently removed from late June 2025 to accommodate two new dedicated signalised left-turn lanes from Anzac Highway onto Marion Road. These changes are required to improve traffic flow, efficiency and safety.

In preparation for this change, Lincoln Avenue will be temporarily closed at the junction of Anzac Highway from mid-May 2025. During the closure, alternative access to Lincoln Avenue will be available via Clayton Avenue and Mabel Street. Once the works are complete, Lincoln Avenue will reopen with the permanent access arrangement in late June 2025.

Permanent pedestrian and cyclists access changes – Marion Road and Cross Road

To accommodate the new overpass at Marion Road and Cross Road, the two existing pedestrian actuated crossings (PACs) where the tram line crosses Marion Road and Cross Road will need to be re-located.

The new locations on Cross Road, west of Maynard Road and on Marion Road, south of Turner Avenue will maintain pedestrian and cyclist connectivity across Marion Road and Cross Road, and access to the new tram stop.

Works to construct the new crossings will commence from mid-late May 2025. The existing

crossings will remain operational until the new crossings are complete in August 2025.

Permanent relocation of Bus Stop 12 Marion Road (west side)

To accommodate the new PAC at Marion Road, the existing Bus Stop 12 Marion Road (west side) will permanently shift approximately 50 metres south. Works to relocate the bus stop include an installation of a new bus stop shelter, seating and permanent signage.

The upgrade works and relocation will start from mid-late May 2025. Public transport users are encouraged to follow on site signage while these works are underway.

SA Power Networks power relocation works

Some minor outages will be required to complete these works and SA Power Networks will directly notify affected properties if there is to be an interruption to power services.

SA water service disruptions and outages

We expect some short-term water supply disruptions for up to one day at a time while works are underway to install new water mains within the project area. **SA Water** (phone: 1300 729 283) will directly notify affected properties in advance.

Intersection upgrades

Works are continuing at the intersections of Marion Road and Anzac Highway and Marion Road and Cross Road ahead the of overpass construction starting in August 2025.

The intersections of Marion Road and Anzac Highway and Marion Road and Cross Road will remain open to traffic during these works.

Speed and lane restrictions, and onsite signage and traffic controllers will be in place to keep everyone safe. Please take care when travelling through the area and follow the directions of traffic controllers.
