South Road Tram Overpass Upgrade

Works update – May to July 2025

We are rebuilding the existing tram overpass on South Road to accommodate the River Torrens to Darlington Project

This update provides information about upcoming works and changes to local access in your area.

These works will occur on South Road and local side streets within and around the tram corridor between Stop 5 (Black Forest) to west of Stop 7 (Glandore).

This includes:

- service investigation and relocation works within the tram corridor
- preparation of rail storage areas and delivery of rail materials within the tram corridor
- continuation of drainage works within the site compound, South Road and commencing works within the tram corridor
- installation of signage on South Road and Anzac Highway
- continuation of overpass offline construction
- pruning and removal of trees and vegetation.

To keep everyone safe speed and lane restrictions will be in place as required. Intermittent local side road detours will also be in place as required, please observe onsite signage and directions of traffic controllers.

Outside of working hours, speed restrictions will remain in place and local road access restored wherever possible. Local access to properties will be maintained at all times but we will contact you directly if short term restrictions are required. Some noise disturbance can be expected at times during construction; however, the work will be managed to minimise noise to nearby residents and businesses as much as practically possible.

Pruning and removal of trees and vegetation

While every effort is made to retain existing vegetation and trees, removals are required as part of the project.

Removals and pruning will occur during the day from mid-May 2025, within the rail corridor and adjacent work areas on Glengyle Terrace, Nottingham Crescent and Aroha Terrace.

Temporary changes to street parking

There will be some temporary restrictions to on-street parking on side streets adjacent the tram corridor during working hours (day or night). Outside of working hours, parking restrictions will be removed wherever possible. Please observe traffic management and onsite signage.

Temporary storage facilities

We are setting up temporary rail storage areas within the rail corridor off Aroha Terrace and Nottingham Crescent. These will be used for the storage of essential railway materials required during major construction.

Access to the Aroha Terrace site will be via East Avenue, and the Nottingham Crescent site via Pleasant Avenue.

Deliveries will take place on the weekends between 7am and 7pm at each location on the following days:

- Sunday 11 May 2025
- Sunday 18 May 2025

Temporary changes to local pedestrian and cyclist access

Pedestrians and cyclists should take care when travelling through the area. There will be some temporary localised changes in and around the work areas, please follow signs and detours for safe access.

Temporary changes to access and traffic conditions

There will temporary speed and lane restrictions along South Road for approximately four weeks from mid-May, between 7pm to 5am.

South Road Bus Stop 7 (to the City) will be temporarily moved 20 meters south during night shift only to allow for night works along South Road, Glandore. Advance notice signage will be provided at the bus stop. South Road Bus Stop 7 (to travel south) will not be affected.

There will be some changes to access for pedestrians and cyclists. Please follow signs and detours for safe access and take care when travelling through the area.
