## South Road Tram Overpass Upgrade

### Fact sheet – Temporary local access changes

Several temporary changes are required to local access and cyclist and pedestrian access during construction of the South Road overpass in Glandore, Everard Park and Black Forest. These changes are important to keep everyone safe.

## Temporary local access changes and road closures

### Norman Terrace

From 28 July 2025 we need to close a section of Norman Terrace at the junction of Aroha Terrace. This closure is required until the project is complete.

Access to properties will be maintained throughout the works. Advance notice will be provided if there is a need to temporarily restrict driveway access. Please see the map below for further details. Detour signs will be in place for safe access. Please follow directions from our traffic controllers.

## Glengyle Terrace

Glengyle Terrace (between Wellington Street and Grosvenor Street) will temporarily close for up to four weeks. It will then reopen.

## Pedestrian access changes

From 1 August 2025, we need to close the Mike Turtur Bikeway on the South Road Overpass between Burke Street, Glandore and Halmon Avenue, Everard Park until the project is complete. Please see the map below for further details.
