






Thebarton Oval, which attracted a crowd of 51,480 people during the Football Season of 1923.



From Virgin Land to Popular Suburb.

Progress of the Corporation of Thebarton.





T is always fascinating and very interesting to peer into the past and peruse the records of our forefathers which have become dim with the fleeting of the years. Our mission is to delve not too deeply into the early pioneering trials of our yet young country; but just to place before the people a brief outline of the history of the Municipality in which they reside; to show the manner in which a tract of land has been cultivated,

and later transformed into an up-to-date and modern suburb, with its footpaths, avenues, private and public buildings, and all other improvements which comprise a well-constructed suburban township.

Although, unfortunately, there is a paucity of information concerning the history of this suburb, we have been able, with the valuable assistance rendered by esteemed old residents, Town Clerk C. E. Wyett, and ex-Alderman Riley, to publish what is, to our knowledge, the first history of the locality.

Undoubtedly Thebarton was the first residential site surveyed outside the City of Adelaide, that is, that portion between Light Terrace on the North and South Terrace on the South, Port Road on the East and West Torrens on the West.

In those far-away days the present town was the camping ground selected by Colonel Light and the representatives of the Queen while surveying the

City of Adelaide. Proof of this is contained in the fact that the home of Colonel Light, in Winwood Street, Southwark, still exists, not in its original state as a pioneer's home, but as a bulk store of one of the factories of the district—so much for the march of progress.

The very name of this Corporation was derived from the fact that Colonel Light had a farm called "The Barton"

It will be noticed by reference to a map of Thebarton that some of the building allotments are surveyed into 30 feet frontages abutting the streets, which are very narrow, with footpaths on which not more than two can walk side by side, a system of survey which is characteristic of the quaint old English villages. This gives the impression that Thebarton was surveyed before Adelaide, for the purpose of giving Colonel Light's staff an opportunity of securing a home of their own, if they so desired. Be that as it may, it can be safely said that the early history of South Australia is closely wrapped round pioneers

southern land wended their way westward from the

circle of the city.

Governor Hindmarsh, the first Governor of this State, lived in Reid Street, next to the site where Faulding & Co.'s factory now stands. Unlike the land on the eastern portion of our capital, the country where our present suburb stands was a beautiful pastoral plain, with scatterings of the majestic eucalypti trees, remnants of which can still be seen in portions of the district.

The first record of this locality coming under the direct control of the people appears in the Government Gazette of July, 1853, under the seal of His Excellency Sir Henry Edward Fox Young. It was then that the District of West Torrens was Gazetted. To give some idea of the scattered nature of the



population at that time, a brief outline of the boundaries of the district is given. On the East it was bounded by the Western boundary of the Park Lands; on the North by the centre of the River Torrens and the Northern boundary of the Hundred of Adelaide; on the South by the centre of the Bay Road, from the Southwest angle of the Park Lands to the sea at Holdfast Bay; and on the West the boundary was marked by the waters of Spencer's Gulf.

Five men at that time constituted the Council, and on account of there being no funds available, the Government at that time, with a view of removing this impediment to the successful operation of the councils within the proclaimed areas, authorised the Colonial Treasurer to make advances to District Councils, to be afterwards repaid by them when in funds. This was done to meet the preliminary expenses and cost of the first assessment.

At the latter end of the seventies of last century a movement was started by some of the residents to have the eastern portion proclaimed a Corporation, to be called the Corporation of the Town of Thebarton, and as no opposition was raised it became an accomplished fact in 1883.

On Thursday, February 6, 1883, the following notice appeared in the Government Gazette:-"Granting the request of ratepayers of the Town of Thebarton, to be incorporated under the provisions of the Corporation Act, and constituting the Town a Municipality by the name of 'Thebarton,' and dividing the Municipality into four wards, and appointing Mayor and Councillors thereof, and rearranging the wards of the District of West Torrens."

To-day the Corporation of Thebarton, which is approximately one-third of the area which was in 1853 under the control of five councillors, has an assessment of £445,341, yielding in rates the sum of £10,669 yearly, compared with the assessment for the District of West Torrens in 1880, then approximately three times the area and including Thebarton, which was £18,364, resulting in revenue of £2,082 yearly.

The first available assessment after that date for Thebarton is in 1909, when the total reached £169,954. By this it will be seen that in a period of 15 years the Town has progressed to the extent of

£275,387 in land values assessment.

The population has increased from 10,000 in 1914 to 16,500 in 1923, while the number of houses

Among improvements made in the district quite recently is the Thebarton Memorial Recreation Ground, which was opened on October 29, 1921, by Sir Archibald Weigall—Mr. J. L. Leal being Mayor at that time. This ground is well situated, its area of 14 acres costing £2,240. Together with other improvements, a fine pavilion, costing £4,000, has been erected. On this reserve there is a football oval, where many strenuous league games have been played; on one occasion, in 1923, the gate receipts proved an attendance of 15,000.

Trotting is also a favourite sport on this oval, and throughout the year is indulged in under the

glow of electric lights.

There are approximately 1,500 children attending the Thebarton Model School, situate on Henley Beach Road. Private schools in the district also cater for the education of the children.






