Balance on the walls. Can you get all the way across without falling off?

KAURNA ACTIVITY

Build a wardli (shelter). Use what you can find on the ground rather than breaking limbs off the trees and shrubs.



ODDS 8 SODS

Find some natural items to make a sculpture, mandala, or other work of art.

KAURNA FACT

The wardli is a dome shaped structure that the Kaurna people built for shelter from branches and grasses and sometimes mud or bark. Small villages are called wardliwardli.
