- This declaration must be witnessed by a Justice of the Peace or a person proclaimed under Schedule 1 clause 1 of the Oaths Act 1936 (eg a legal practitioner, a proclaimed officer).
- Responsibility for payment will remain with you if this Declaration is not properly completed and submitted to the City of West Torrens before the due date for payment of notice.
- Only the registered owner of a vehicle can dispute an expiation for a parking offence unless the owner has provided the driver's name and address on a statutory declaration.
- The Oaths Act 1936 provides a maximum penalty of 4 years imprisonment for any person who knowingly makes a Statutory Declaration which is untrue in any regards.
